One of our **brand-new programs** we're rolling out is our **Fisher pipette tip box recycling!** We've purchased some recycling boxes that will take **any brand** that is clean, dry, and without any tips.

We rolled these out May 14th and in one week accumulated over 83 boxes! You can find them in R2, 2nd floor, by Smyth lab Trex box and in R4, 2nd floor (across from B2305, by the centrifuge).

Thank you for continuing to collect the Styrofoam* and plastics for our on-going programs!

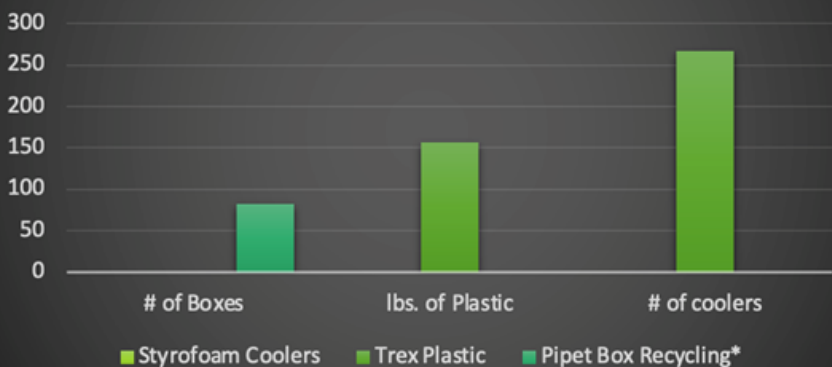
*Reminder that the Styrofoam you need to **remove all stickers, tape, and labels. Also make sure it is only white foam** not food grade (egg cartons, takeout containers, etc.) *

What to do with those annoying gel packets that are taking up lab space?

We've done the research and even if your bags don't have the recycling symbol on them, they are considered non-toxic but not drain safe.

Allow the gel to thaw, cut open the bags, dispose of the gel in the trash, rinse and allow to dry, and dispose in the Trex box.
