Trex is a company that takes plastic films that are otherwise thrown away and turns them into decking and outdoor furniture. This month we would like to challenge all labs to recycle clean plastic films and bags in the receptacles labeled Trex located on each floor in the wet lab areas. Items that can be recycled include: produce bags, store bags, ice bags, clean Ziplock and other reclosable bags, case overwrap, bread bags, newspaper sleeves, bubble wrap, and plastic e-commerce mail envelopes. As a general rule, if its stretchy and clean it can go in the bin.

If we, as an FBRI community, can collect 500 lbs. of plastic in the next 6 months we will be rewarded with a free outdoor bench! You can also bring products from your house (as long it's clean and stretchy) to help us achieve this goal. Thank you for your participation in our next challenge!
