Interactome protocol

This protocol will allow you to use information online to search for all proteins that have been confirmed (by yeast-two-hybrid system and/or co-immunoprecipitation) to physically interact with a protein of interest.

Procedures

- 1. Go to https://www.ebi.ac.uk/intact/
- 2. Enter the gene name, such as prkaa1, into "Search in IntAct" box then click "search"
- 3. Click "interactors" tab. A drop down list of proteins that this protein, here AMPKα1, has been documented to interact with will appear.
- 4. For each protein listed, click the link to UniProt.org, under the "Link" column.
- 5. Document the following information for each protein in an excel spreadsheet:
 - a. Protein name
 - b. Gene
 - c. Organism
 - d. Subcellular location (e.g. nucleus, cytoplasm, mitochondria, etc)
